Oil the spring in the pivot sections or replace the spring with a new one if it is faulty or too old. Use a small pair of pliers to remove it, if necessary. Place a small amount of clock oil onto the gears within the clock, and oil the clock mechanisms once every three years for maintenance.

A bent, kinked, twisted or torn suspension spring can cause a clock to stop. If the spring looks damaged at all it should be replaced. If a clock has a wobbly pendulum it is often caused by a twisted or partially torn spring. Like hand washers you can and should purchase a good assortment of suspension springs.

The first and easiest problem to fix is restoring the clock's battery power, which is done by removing the battery from the back of the clock and replacing it with a fresh one.

Below is a description of the many steps involved in the restoration of an antique American clock movement. For the most part the same steps will apply to almost any type of clock. I chose this clock movement as an example because it is the most common movement that most repair shops will encounter.

Clock Movement Restoration - Master Clock Repair

Step 1. Assess your skill level and the scope of the needed repair. If you have any experience with small mechanics, are patient and have a steady hand, you can easily repair the clock's suspension spring. This repair is the cheapest, easiest and most common one to make.

How to Repair an Anniversary Clock | Hunker

To operate this clock, first find a home for it on a shelf or mantle that does not shake or get bumped. Hang the balls on gently while the spring is sitting right where it normally sits. Adjust the feet of the clock base so the clock sits level with the balls centered in the middle of the cup below it.

Repair the 400 day Anniversary style clock. - Clockworks

Use cotton gloves or a soft cloth when handling the pendulum or weights. For clocks with a cable-driven movement, wind the weights all the way up. For clocks with chains, use a long wire or string and put it through the chain links just below the chain sprocket. When done properly, the wire or string should go through six chain links.

To fix this problem, open the door, or panel, by the clock face. Find the click spring. The click spring is located just behind the moon dial itself. Pull the click spring back about a half inch from the teeth of the moon dial, and then allow it to fall back into place.

Fortunately, there is a simple cuckoo clock repair that can be made to the pendulum wire as a next step. You can try using a wide screwdriver to bend the pendulum wire slightly to the the right or left. (The pendulum wire is in the long hole on the bottom of the body of the cuckoo clock.)

1) Set the clock upon a level surface completely free from vibration. 2) There is a brass protruding tube located at the back of the clock through which passes a delicate suspension wire assembly (Figure I). The tube has two sections, the lower part (A) holds the suspension wire in position while the clock is in transit.
