Agitated and distressed, and not yet clearly perceiving it to be the fixed purpose of God (ver. 29) that Saul should no longer reign over Israel as his recognised servant and vicegerent, Samuel gave himself unto prayer, if thereby he might avert the calamity. Respecting his intercession, consider - I. ON WHOSE BEHALF IT WAS MADE. Chiefly, doubtless, on behalf of Saul, though not without regard to the nation, on which his rejection seemed likely to produce a disastrous effect.

Samuel's Intercession for Saul

Intercessory prayer is an act of communion with Christ, for Jesus pleads for the sons of men. It is a part of his priestly office to make intercession for his people. He hath ascended up on high to this end, and exercises this office continually within the veil.

It is clear, therefore, that he had been in the continual habit and practice of praying for Israel; he could not peak of ceasing to pray if he had not hitherto continued in prayer. Answer: Speaking of Jesus, the writer to the Hebrews says, "Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them" (Hebrews 7:25). This verse (and others like it) tells us that although Christ's work to secure the salvation of the elect was completed on the cross, as evidenced by His cry "It is finished!" (John 19:30), His care for His redeemed children will never be finished.

In His daily prayers for us He bears our burdens (Ps. 68:19); and even when we are old and gray He will still carry us along and deliver us out of trouble (Is. 46:4). He accomplishes all this through His continual work of intercession. 9. He prays for us. There are many things Jesus is asking the Father to do for us.

The Three Offices of Christ

Mary's intercession is so powerful because she is our queen mother, and the king will never refuse the queen. Just like Solomon, Jesus too will never refuse his mother (unlike Bathsheba, she won't ask for anything bad), and we actually see this play out in the New Testament.
