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Teaching Question And Answer Relationships

The question-answer relationship (QAR) strategy helps students understand the different types of questions. By learning that the answers to some questions are "Right There" in the text, that some answers require a reader to "Think and Search," and that some answers can only be answered "On My Own," students recognize that they must first consider the question before developing an answer.

Question-Answer Relationship (QAR) | Classroom Strategies ...

Question-Answer Relationships, or QAR, is a reading comprehension strategy developed to "clarify how students approach the tasks of reading texts and answering questions" (Raphael 1986). It encourages students to be active, strategic readers of texts.

Question-Answer Relationships - TeacherVision

In this strategy, students are taught to use four question/answer relationships (QAR's) to find the information they need to answer the question. The teacher introduces QAR and explains the four types of question/answer relationships (QAR's). The teacher models the QAR process by using a short reading passage. First read the story and questions to the students. Then identify which QAR's are evidenced through the questions given. Finally, answer questions and discuss.
