Writing a Literature Review. A literature review is a document or section of a document that collects key sources on a topic and discusses those sources in conversation with each other (also called synthesis).The lit review is an important genre in many disciplines, not just literature (i.e., the study of works of literature such as novels and plays).

Start by reading the abstract and the headings in order to identify the author's thesis and the source's main ideas. Then, read the source from start to finish and highlight the key terms. Record the relevant information in a reading journal. – Compare the sources.

At the beginning of any paper, define your paper's purpose so that the literature review will be anchored to a specific point of view.

A literature review is a piece of writing that demonstrates you have sound understanding and knowledge of your field of study or research in a particular field, topic or question. It can be a chapter in a thesis or a stand-alone paper like a term paper or review article of a publication.

### A Step-By-Step Guide on How to Write a Good Literature Review

If your topic gives no directions about how to organize the review, you might begin by listing what you see as the book's most important strengths and weaknesses, then construct your thesis accordingly; for example, "Although Mary Smith's The Lost Continent is clearly organized and thorough, its arguments about colonization are ultimately unconvincing." Such a thesis would help guide the structure of your essay: first analyze Smith's organization and thoroughness, and then discuss ...

A literature review often forms part of a larger research project, such as within a thesis (or major research paper), or it may be an independent written work, such as a synthesis paper. Purpose of a literature review A literature review situates your topic in relation to previous research and illuminates a spot for your research.

### Writing a Literature Review FINAL

A literature review requires a synthesisof different subtopics to come to a greater understanding of the state of knowledge on a larger issue. It works very much like a jigsaw puzzle. The individual pieces (arguments) must be put together in order to reveal the whole (state of knowledge).

### Writing A Literature Review and Using a Synthesis Matrix ...

When writing your literature review, place background information, for example, explanations of a theoretical model or clinical situation, at sections where it will be most helpful for your readers. For instance, if various researchers have utilized a similar theoretical approach, define that framework before reviewing those studies.

### Literature Review Examples - A Guide to Writing

A literature review can be just a simple summary of the sources, but it usually has an organizational pattern and combines both summary and synthesis. A summary is a recap of the important information of the source, but a synthesis is a re-organization, or a reshuffling, of that information.
